Every day is different offering a variety of activities and excursions: by launch, kayak, walks in the rainforest, fishing for piranhas, swimming or just strolling through remote and unspoilt villages. What ever activity you decide on, you can be sure to return to the comfort of the boat where a refreshing drink will be waiting for you accompanied by wonderful cuisine. M/V Tucano can also be chartered for groups of up to 8 guests and is the only vessel with solar powered refrigeration, electric motors and solar heated showers.

Manaus was built on the success of the rubber boom in the 1870's and is home to the famous Opera House or Teatro Amazonas, reflecting the opulence of those days. Other highlights to consider include the Pantanal in Mato Grosso, a vast network of wetlands with excellent wildlife and the spectacular waterfalls of Iguacu which lie on the borders of Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay.
